The donations requested are:

Winter coats for men, women, teens and children

Winter clothes, gloves & scarves for men, women, teens and children

Bedding – comforters, blankets, pillows (new), sheets, etc.

Diapers and wipes (do not need any baby formula or food)

Household items: pots/pans, silverware, etc. (no glass items)

Men's work gloves and boots

Toiletries (shaving cream, deodorant, razors)

Cleaning supplies and detergent
